PCPL 4.0 Code of Conduct

The Pulaski County Public Library is a safe area for the learning and enjoyment of children and adults of all ages. Foul and abusive language or threatening behavior towards staff, fellow patrons, or elsewhere in the library will not be tolerated. Individuals will be asked to leave the premises immediately if this occurs.

To maintain an environment consistent with the library's mission, operational capacity, and insurance coverage, meeting rooms and public spaces may not be used to provide health-related services involving direct client interactions and supervision.

Such activities may require levels of privacy, confidentiality, and regulatory compliance (e.g., HIPAA) that the library is not equipped or insured to provide or support. Therefore, organizations or individuals representing healthcare, mental health, skills training, or supervised visits are ineligible to reserve library meeting spaces or formally conduct therapeutic services with clients in public spaces.
